7. Any Other Business

Open Heaven have been setting up equipment prior to the end of Fever Sunday sessions, causing a hazard with moving equipment and irritating members through the use of sound and lighting. Michelle is to talk members of Open Heaven to ensure set-up takes place after Fever sessions.
